I am requesting funding for improvements to the Mill Road Intersection located in Byron, Illinois, in the surface transportation reauthorization legislation.


The project sponsor for this project is the City of Byron and the project is located between Tower Road and Mill Road in Byron, Illinois, 61010

The funding is designated for conversion of an existing T-intersection to a roundabout.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars. Safety concerns at this intersection have been prevalent for years. Over the last 10 years, there have been 8 accidents, including 1 fatality. Construction of a new roundabout will greatly reduce traffic conflicts and reduce the likelihood of traffic accidents.
